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Strategies Utilized for In-Person and eLearning Instruction

- Implement 3-week Humanities units and 3-week Math units.
- Implement Close Reading of informational texts within all classrooms.
- Provide daily instruction of mathematical problem-solving to students.
- Assess using common tiered formative assessments in ELA and Math to determine mastery of skills.
- Analyze student assessment data to determine remediation and/or enrichment for students.
- Implementing an aligned S.M.A.R.T. Goal Process (School-PLC-Teacher-Student).
- Utilize Professional Learning Communities to analyze common assessment, NWEA data, "Answers in the Room PD".
